All boats should monitor VHF channel 71 for START instructions and ongoing communication during the race

- 1. OA, Rules. The Amelia Island Sailing Club is the Organizing Authority for the race, which will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (Rules, RRS).
- 2. Schedule of Race (All times GPS)
 - a. 0945 Roll Call
 - b. 0955 Five-minute alert, engines off
 - c. 0958 Two-minute alert
 - d. 0959 One-minute alert
 - e. 1000 START Race One

There will be three races using the same course. The second and third races will begin approximately five minutes after the last boat finishes the previous race as broadcast by the Race Committee. The low-point scoring system from the three races will be added together to determine the overall winner for the day.

- 3. RACE COURSE (Approximately 2.3 nautical miles). Forecast at the START, winds from East/Southeast @ 14-16 knots
- 4. START LINE Imaginary line between Cumberland Sound Lighted Buoy Red 26 and Green 27 (leave Red 26 to port)
 - Mark 1 Amelia River Lighted Buoy Green 23 (Starboard Rounding)
 - Mark 2 Amelia River Lighted Buoy Red 2 (Starboard Rounding))
 - FINISH LINE Imaginary line between Cumberland Sound Lighted Buoy Red 26 and Green 27 (leave Green 27 to port)

Record your GPS time when the bow of your boat crosses the finish line. A headsail set forward of the bow does not qualify as a finish. This is a change to align with the *Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024*, modified 1-1-2021.

Report your time to Cathy Eichmann on VHF channel 71, or by mobile phone at 401-440-4341.

- 5. COURTESY BROADCAST: The Race Committee will use VHF Channel 71 to attempt to broadcast information on boats early over the line. Failure to receive or hear such radio transmission will not be grounds for redress. This is a change to RRS 60.1.
- 6. RETIREMENT: Any competitor retiring from the race shall immediately notify Race Committee on Channel 71.
- 7. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, "Decision to Race". The organizing authority will not accept any liability, nor be liable, for any damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the regatta.
