FINISH LINE – Imaginary line between Amelia River Lighted Buoys Red 4 and Green 5 (LEAVE RED 4 to STARBOARD)

Record your GPS time when the bow of your boat crosses the finish line. A headsail set forward of the bow does not qualify as a finish. This is a change to align with the *Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024*.
